Summary

- The energetic and fiery Hugh Wolff started his career in his home country with positions in New Jersey and Saint Paul. Hailed as one of the most brilliant and interesting young American conductors of that time, he was soon invited to conduct all the major orchestras of America and Europe.
- Eventually he moved to Europe and as Principal Conductor of the Frankfurt Radio Symphony Orchestra helped establish that orchestra as a flexible and highly motivated orchestra of a very high quality.
- Throughout his working life Wolff has been interested in education. Whenever he works with orchestras he tries to involve young people.
- Wolff has made a name for serious and dynamic music making. His repertoire choices, ranging from Baroque to contemporary, are always inventive.
